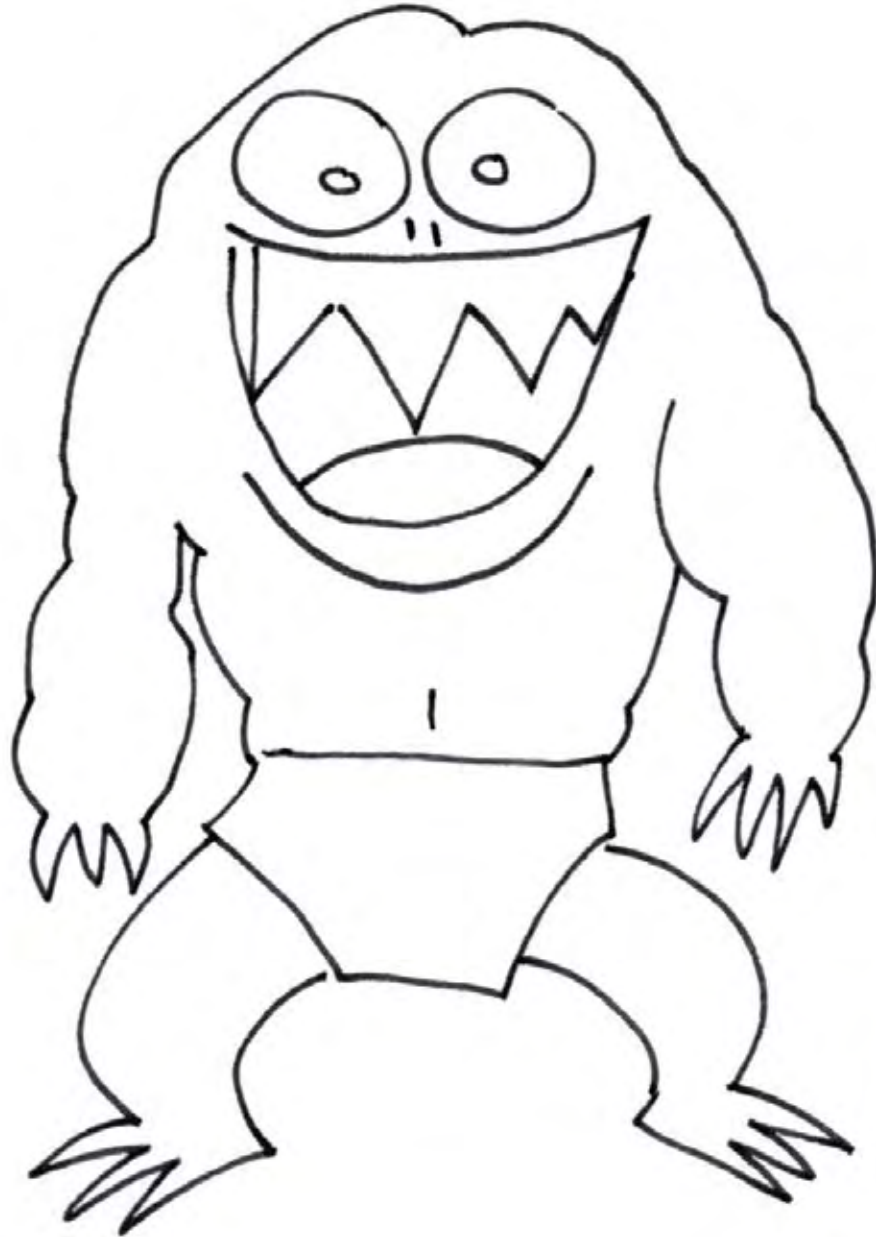

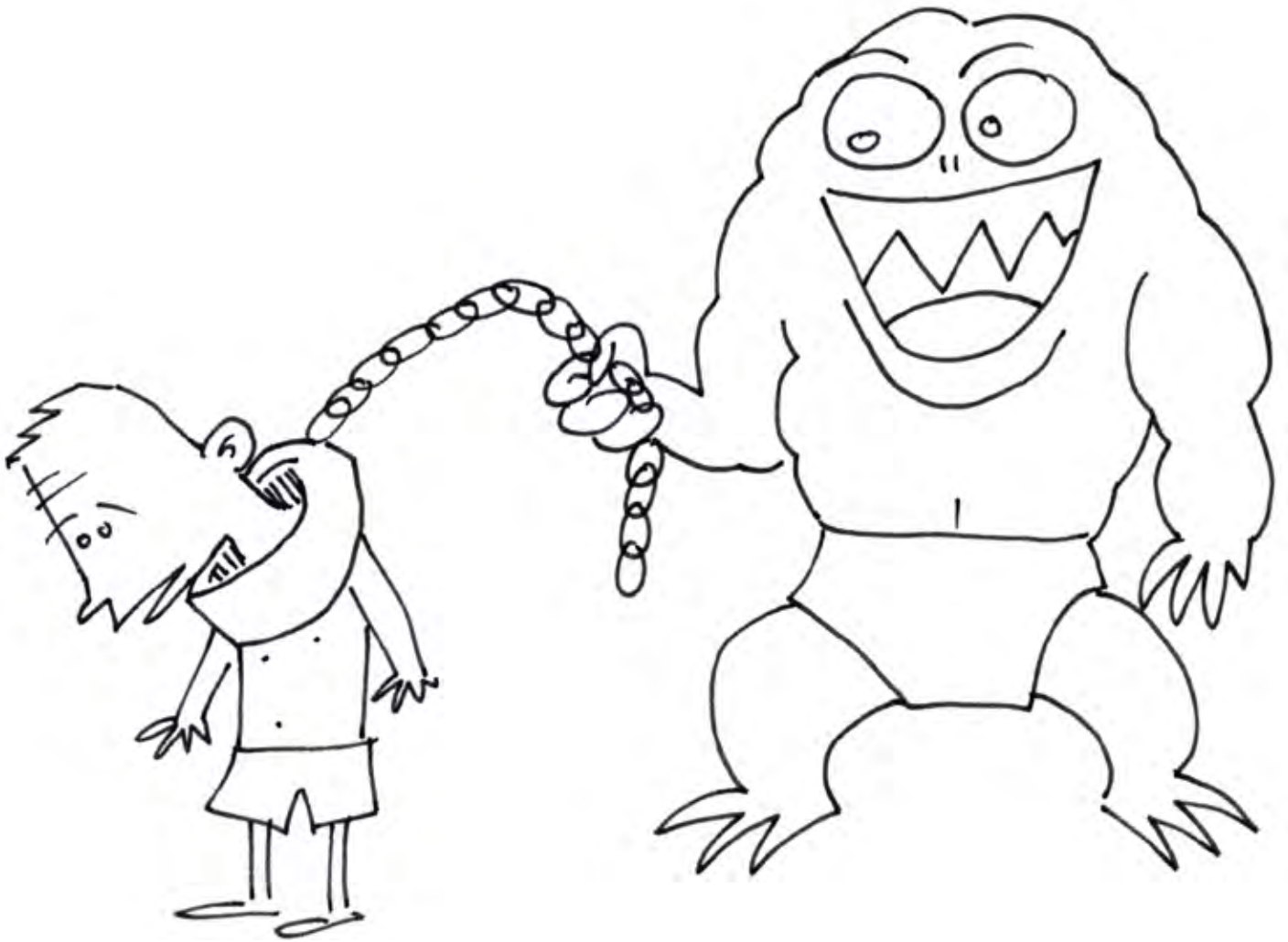
This is you.

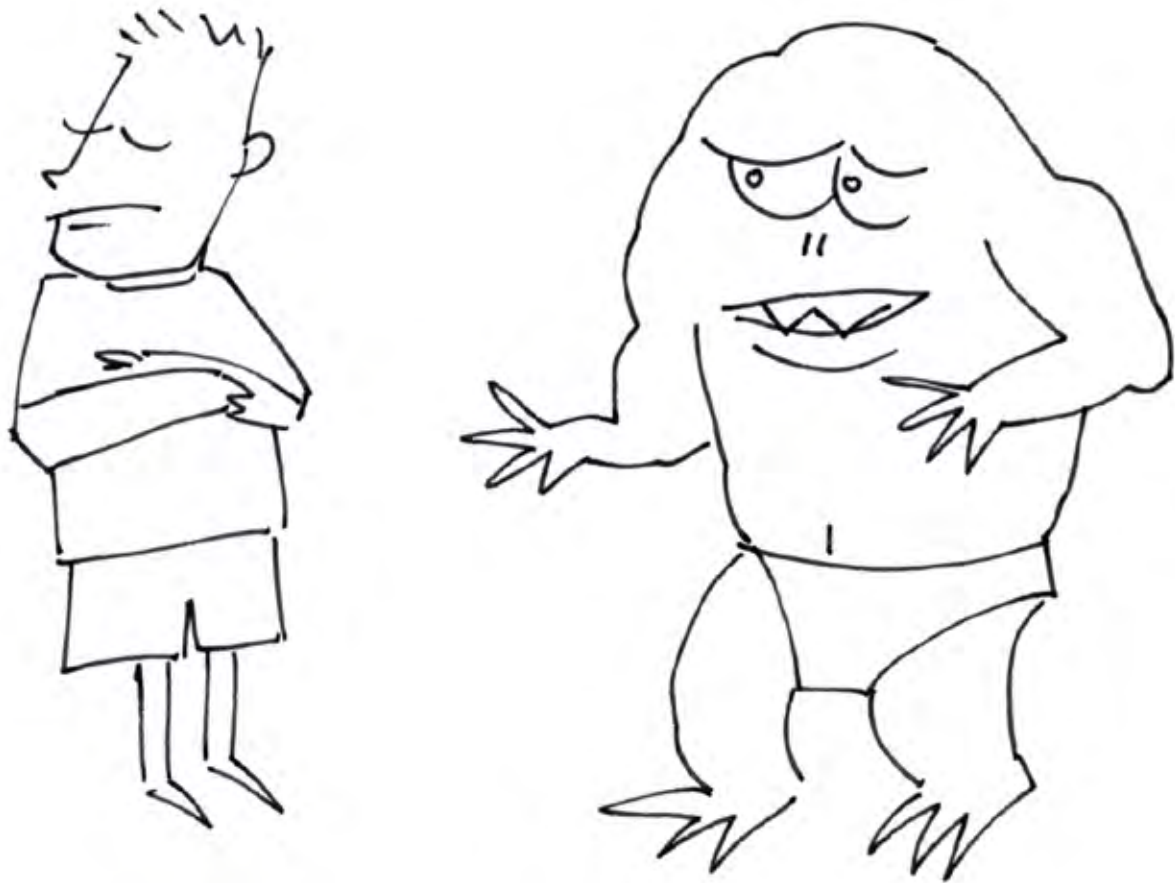
*Before Jesus saves us, this

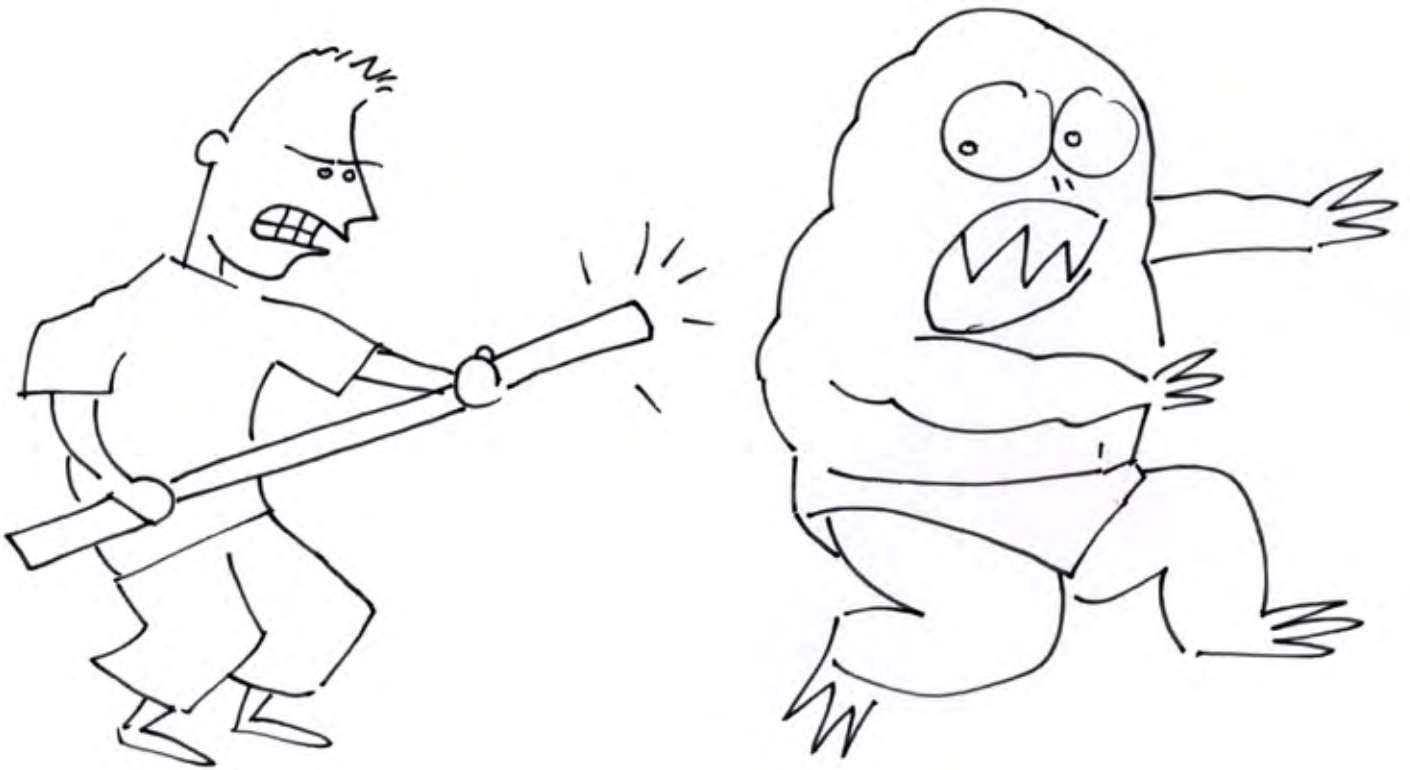
This is what happens when we trust

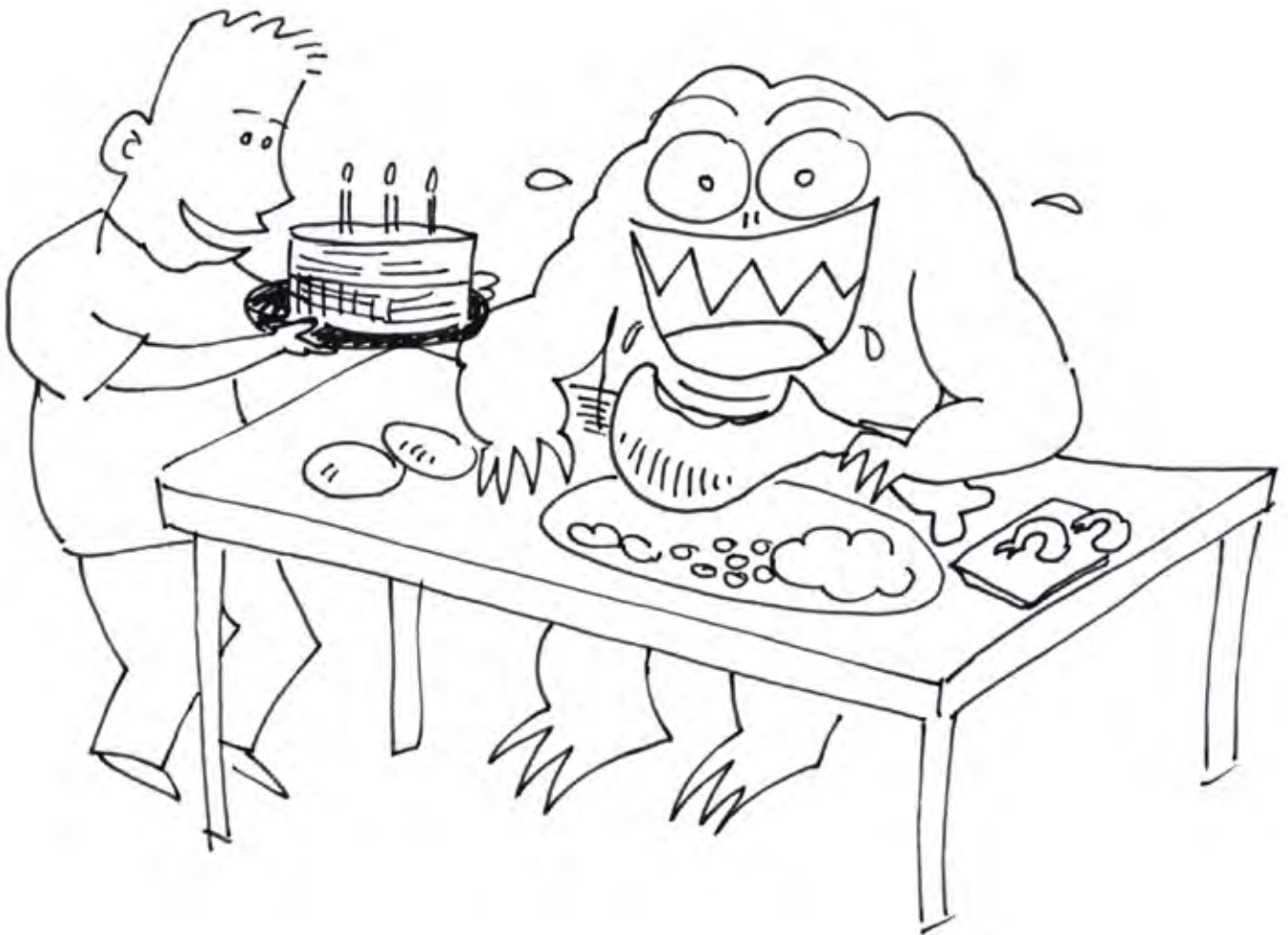
*But our flesh doesn't disappear.

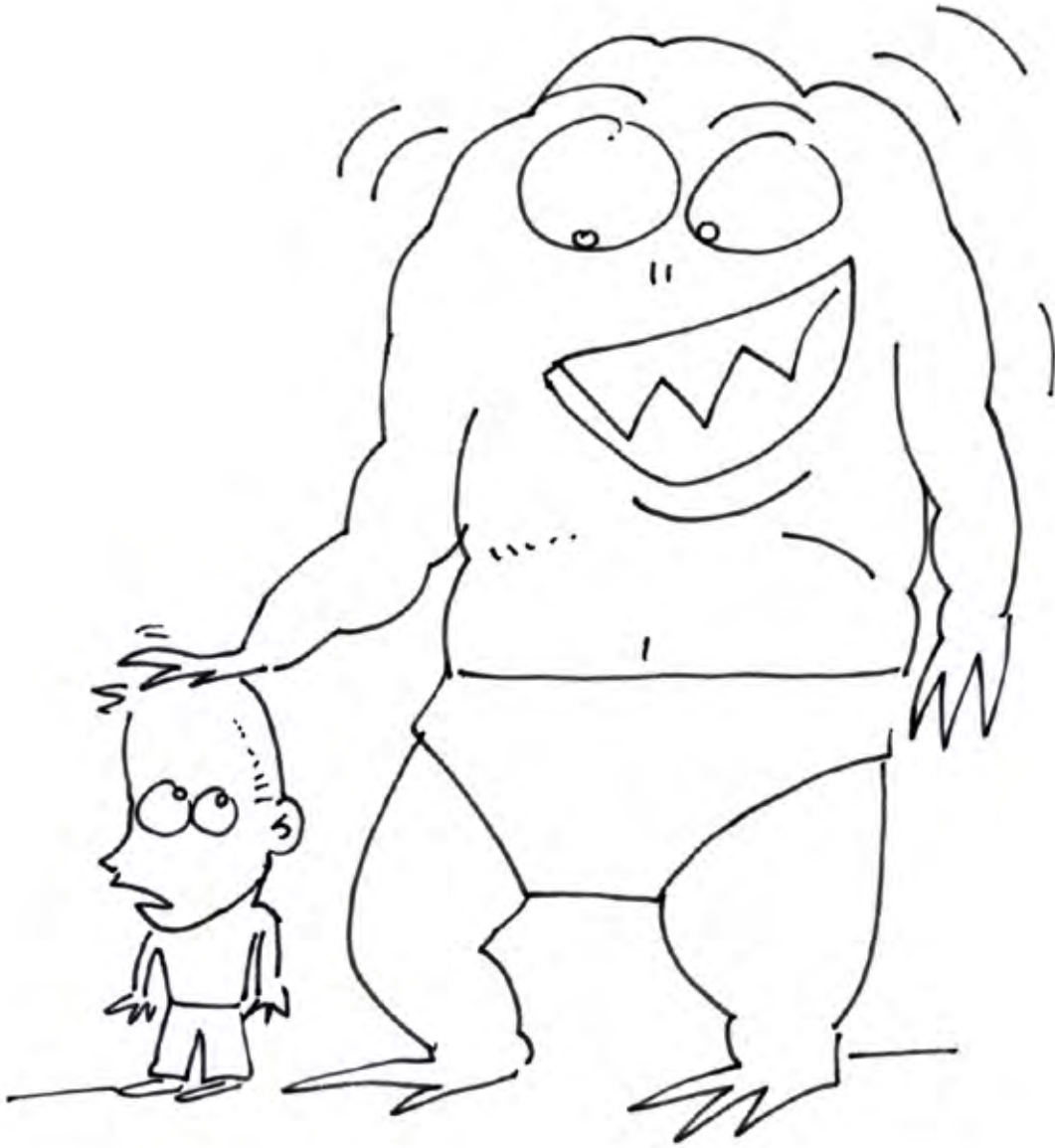
**That's why the Bible tells us

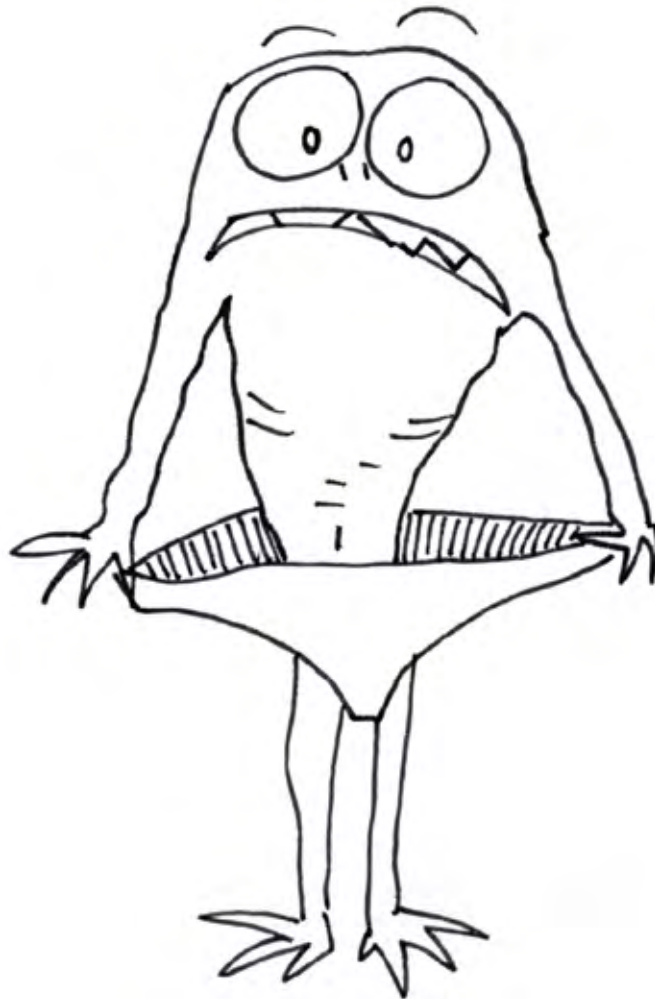
Too often, Christians make friends with their flesh. In fact, they feed it. When we give in to our sinful desires and feed our flesh...
